Invention Convention (all grades) July 25-29

Engineers and entrepreneurs build science skills and collaborate on an invention by ideating, designing, building, testing, and communicating results in a Shark-Tank style presentation. Students present their inventions to the community at the end of the week! Grouped by grades K-2, 3-5, and 6-8.



Guardians of Reading (all grades) August 1-5

Readers dig into the history of the franchise and the name transition to the Guardians. Younger students ask "What does it mean to be a Guardian?" and explore the relationship between cities and teams. Older students read about Cleveland history, Native American history, and issues in contemporary sports. Grouped by grades K-2, 3-5, and 6-8.

Numbers in the World (all grades) August 8-12

Scholars collaborate to solve complex real-world problems, reinforce key mathematical concepts, and develop mathematical literacy. At the end of the week, students present their mathematical findings in presentations or videos. Grouped by grades K-2, 3-5, and 6-8.



Learning 101(grades 6-8 only) August 15-19

Scholars develop the organizational, cognitive, and self-management skills to prepare for high school by managing complex projects. Focuses also on research skills to sort fact from fiction during online research projects.

Programs run 8 am to 12 pm at SDS with a snack. Cost is \$200/program, except Guardians week, which is \$250. Aftercare until 5 pm will be available at an additional cost. Programs may be cancelled on July 1 if < 6 students enroll.

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
